one couple in Club 1 and Club 3 Gd Prix and Libre

one couple in Club 2 and Club 3 Gd Prix and Libre

The chef d’equipe must give the names of the couples(rider/horse) in the team to the Secretary on Friday 16th June between 15.00 and 19.00.

Places will be decided: by calculating the average of the averages of each of the 4 team members’ results.

Prize-giving: Sunday 18th June (at the end of the Elegance classes)

Only the first 3 teams will be placed

The Chef d’equipe will be present at the prize-giving.

Dressage classes are run according to FFE (French federation) rules.
