

















TSC Hat Recommendations 2025 V1 Nov 2024

We recommend that at all times, correctly secured skull caps/riding hats that meet one of the current standards as listed below, should be worn by all riders. However, when jumping in the ring, all practice areas or collecting areas, all riders must wear correctly secured skull caps/riding hats that meet one of the following current standards as listed below:

Hats should meet all of the requirements of one of the following rows:
